The newly designed kitchen brings modern updates to the 20-year-old "home away from home" – providing families a place to prepare fresh meals, share stories, and support each other while newborn babies and children receive state-of-the-art care at St. Charles Medical Center.

Over 200 volunteer hours went into the kitchen renovation with R&H Construction as the project lead.
